Does not include other EBHV models previously funded or eligible for future funding based on CCF-established criteria.

### Length of time programs have existed in WA

- Varies. Some have been in place for decade, some just a few years. New EHS sites are coming on now.

### Administration & Funding

- Under CCF leadership, WA EBHV system was established in 2007
  - State agency, state dollars
  - Local match
- Now in transition
  - Creation of new “home visiting services account” controlled by Dept. of Early Learning leveraging private \$
  - Possible changes as part of planning for new federal \$

### Key Stakeholders

- Home Visiting Coalition, state agencies (health, early learning, social services), foundations/private funders (Gates, United Way of King County)

### System Strengths

- Established ‘approach’
  - Preparation: definitions of evidence, outreach
  - Portfolio of qualifying programs
  - Co-learning
  - CQI for program development
  - Evaluation
- Legislative & funder commitment
