WHEREAS, Michigan is dedicated to increasing the awareness of the importance of relationships, mental health, and social and emotional development in the early years of life and to celebrating the families and caregivers who raise Michigan's children; and,

WHEREAS, we must work together as a community to increase awareness and public understanding of the critical importance of healthy relationships between infants, toddlers, parents, and early childhood caregivers; and,

WHEREAS, data shows the need to address disparities and ensure equitable access to services and programs that support infants, toddlers, young children, and their families; and,

WHEREAS, the state is committed to improving opportunities and outcomes for infants, toddlers, young children, and their families through strategic investments, continued collaboration, and strategic partnerships; and,

WHEREAS, one week each year is dedicated to officially celebrating infants, toddlers, young children, their families, and early childhood professionals; and,

WHEREAS, through public awareness campaigns, intentional community outreach, networking, and social action, babies, their families, and those that support them are celebrated; and,
